Q. Where is the main airport on Maui?

A. The main airport on Maui is **Kahului Airport (OGG)**. There are smaller commuter airports in Kapalua (West Maui) and Hana (East Maui). It's about a 50-minute drive from Kahului Airport to the Hyatt Regency Maui Resort.

Q. Do I need a car to get around on Maui?

A. You can get around Maui by shuttle, tour bus, taxi, or public transportation. Numerous activities are accessible from the Hyatt without needing a car. Maui in March has a warm climate with little precipitation and an average high of 81F & low of 64F. Pack a light jacket or sweater for the evenings, or a heavier jacket if you plan to visit Haleakala Crater (10,000 ft). Dress for the conference is casual. REGISTRATION

Q. When and how will I receive my conference confirmation?

A. Email confirmations are automatically generated after completing the registration process.

Q. When does registration end? Is there a limit on the number of attendees?

A. Registration is open until the conference starts and we can typically accept "last-minute" registrations. Q. What forms of payment does the conference accept?

A. Credit card, cash or check.

Q. When will I receive my CME Certificate?

A. To receive your accreditation certificate we must receive your evaluation form. The CME evaluation form will be sent to the email address used during registration. Certificates will be automatically generated once your completed evaluation form is received. PLEASE NOTE: You will need to fill out the evaluation form to receive a certificate.

Q. Will childcare be provided?

ADULT WORKSHOPS

Q. What workshops go outside and what do I need to bring?

A. AWEF, Ocean Survival Skills, Wilderness Survival: Learn to Return, and Fire Building for Survival go outside. Please dress for the weather, wear close-toed shoes and bring water, sunscreen, and a hat. The Ocean Survival workshop will be in the pool, so wear your swimsuit.

Q. How physically demanding are the Survival workshops?

A. You will need to be able to walk around to different field sites. Other hands-on skills are optional and if there is something that you are unable to perform, please inform the instructor.

Q. Who can attend the Marine Biology/Marine Animal Identification Workshop?

A. This workshop is designed for the whole family! You will learn about the different marine animals in the area and it is open to all ages. Please register each member of your family that is attending the workshop.

YOUTH WORKSHOPS

Q. Does a parent or guardian need to drop off and pick up the youth at each workshop?

A. Yes. If this is not possible, please speak with the instructor prior the workshop start.

Q. What youth workshops go outside?

A. Survival for Teens.

Q. Do any youth workshops require specific attire?

A. Survival for Teens - closed toed shoes, sun protection, and a rain jacket are recommended.
